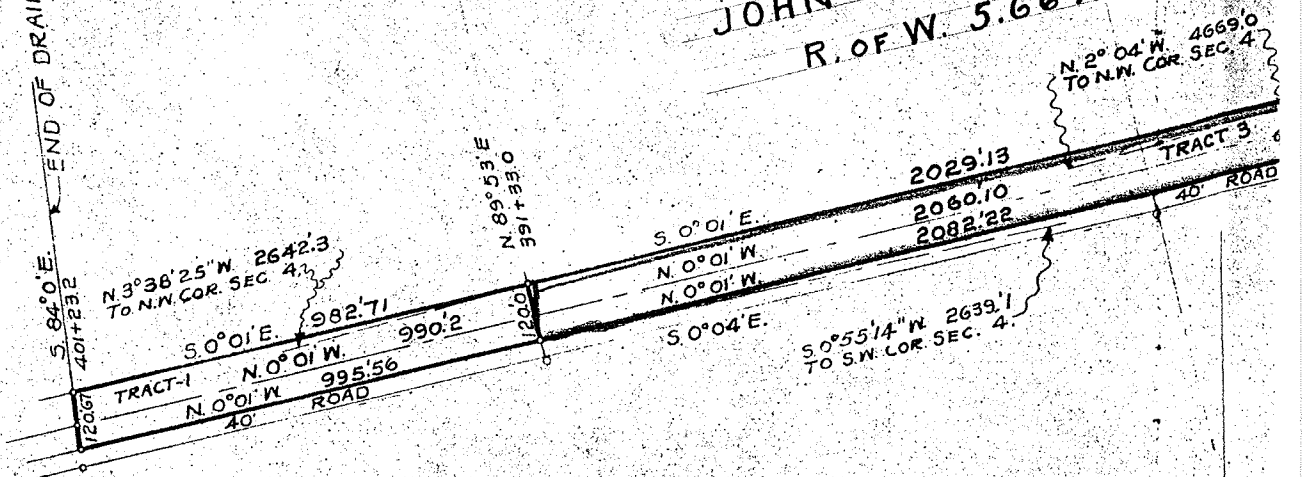




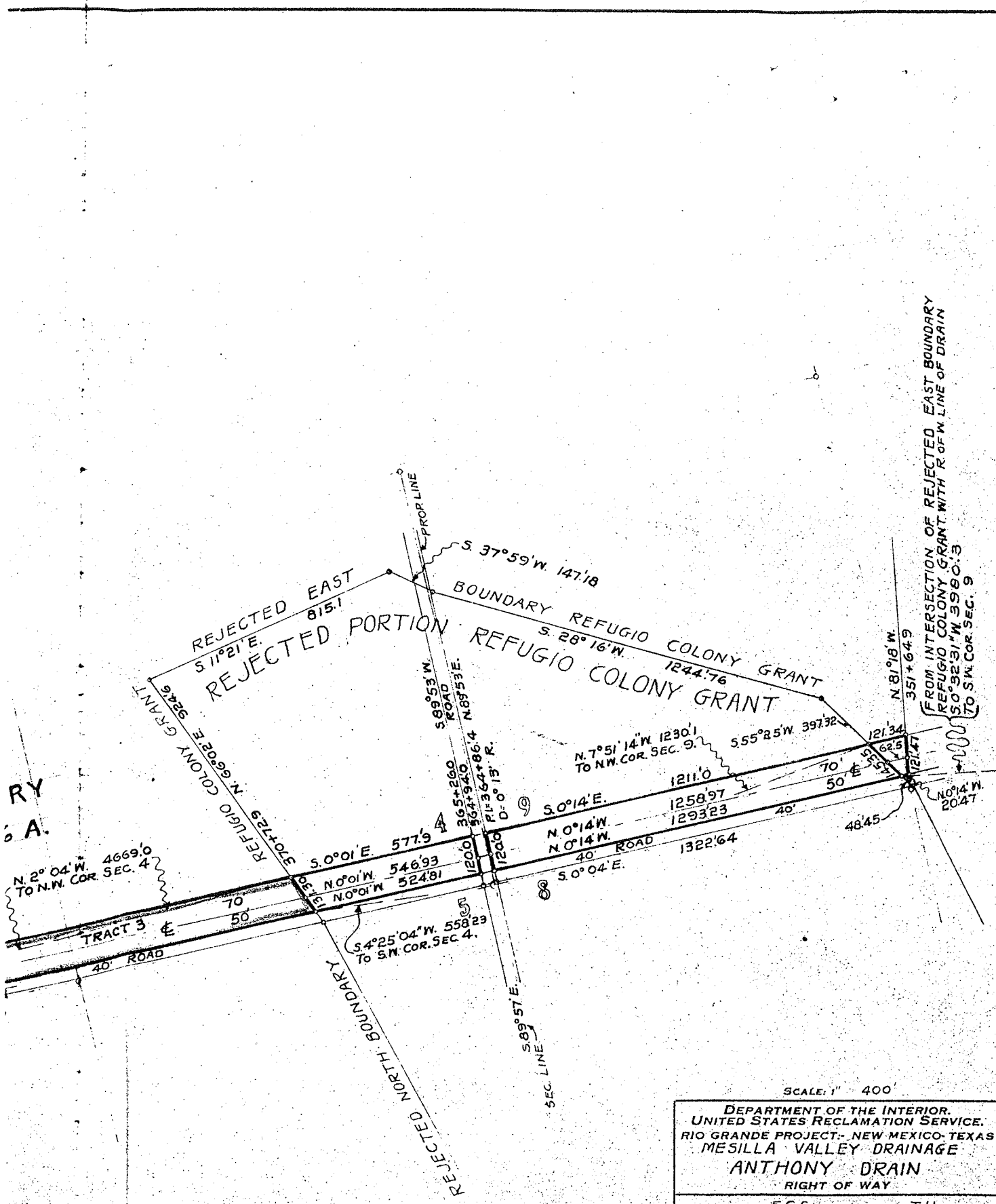
Location Plot S. R. 3E,

In the matter of requiring of right of way through your land, the Reclamation Service hereby offers you the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100) per acre for the land described as follows, to-wit:

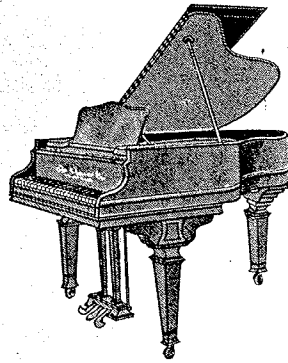
