Further reference is made to the matter of right-ofways forhat is known as the Ascarate wasteway, an adjunct of the Franklin canal, regarding which I have had some conversation with you:

carate grant amounts to about 7/10 of an acre, and it is manifest that the advantages accruing to the owners of this grant will more than compensate for the land taken in this connection. It is estimated by our engineers that the cost of filling in the land for the silting up of which it is proposed to furnish water from the proposed wasteway would cost at the very lowest estimate between \$2,000 and \$3,000, even though there was dirt of a suitable character nearby, and under the conditions obtaining it no doubt would cost more than the amount stated.

As you know, the proposition is that the right-of-way be donated by the owners affected, and that the latter contribute the sum of \$1,000 for the necessary structure underneath the county road for carrying the water, in return for which will be furnished for silting up the land of the grant and the other owners interested, and who share in this arrangement.

It is my belief that this arrangement is highly advantageous to the owners affected. If this proposition is not satisfactory it will be necessary to institute suit in condemnation to acquire the necessary right-of-way, in which event of course the owners of the land would not be afforded the facilities or privilege of using water for silting purposes. It is not thought that the compensation which would be allowed by the appraisers would be anything like sufficient to bear the cost of filling in the remaining land of the owners.

It is necessary that some kind of arrangement be made for the right-of-way at an early date in order that the structures may be ready by the commencement of the ensuing irrigation season, and for this reason I should appreciate it if you will take the matter up with the interested parties and ascertain whether or not the arrangement proposed meets with their approval.
