
Our district has cleaned and maintained the area as shown on the enclosed map, and we feel that the entire length of the Fabens Waste Channel should be owned by adverse possession.

It has been determined that the portion of land that was cleaned by you in 1983 on the Fabens Wasteway Channel does belong to the United States Bureau of Reclamation by adverse possession.

Since the property in question (and outlined in red on the enclosed map) is the property of Reclamation, the operation and maintenance of that portion is the responsibility of the El Paso County Water Improvement District #1.

The agreement between the International Boundary and Water Commission and Hudspeth County Conservation and Reclamation District does not include the portion in question.
