To have and to hold all of the right, title, interest, estate and claim of the said El Paso Valley Water Users Association in and to the said premises, rights and properties, together with all and singular the rights, privileges and appurtenances to the same in any manner belonging, unto the United States of America and unto its successors and assigns forever.
