Situated in El Paso County, Texas, beginning at a point of rock in the Rio Grande above the City of El Paso, 650 feet more or less above the old Santa Fe Railroad well, from which beginning point an alamo bears N. $6^{\circ}35'E$, 67- $\frac{7}{10}$ feet and another Alamo bears N. $22^{\circ}50'$ N. 93- $\frac{5}{10}$ feet. At 2513 feet center of Texas and Pacific Railway track. At 2793 change course.

Thence N. $18^{\circ}30'E$ 1047 feet; Thence N. $16^{\circ}27'E$ 913 feet; Thence N. $28^{\circ}07'N$ 487 feet; Thence N. $13^{\circ}00'E$ 250 feet; Thence N. $6^{\circ}05'E$ 250 feet; Thence N. $27^{\circ}45'E$ 445 feet; thence N. 1222 feet along the line between Cotton and Bassett's Additions in the City of El Paso; thence N. $52^{\circ}40'E$ at 2520 feet, the West line of East El Paso Town tract, at 2826- $\frac{6}{10}$ feet change course. Thence East 3452- $\frac{4}{10}$ feet; thence S. $58^{\circ}45'E$ 2172 feet; Thence N. $83^{\circ}34'E$ 4634 feet along old Texas & Pacific grade; Thence N. $44^{\circ}34'E$ 541 feet; thence N. $75^{\circ}34'E$ 1939 feet; Thence S. $65^{\circ}24'E$ 1370 feet; Thence S. $52^{\circ}15'E$ 200 feet; Thence S. $65^{\circ}34'E$ 1350 feet; thence N. $69^{\circ}E$ 745 feet; thence N. $88^{\circ}45'E$ 1850 feet; thence S. $67^{\circ}45'E$ at ^{383 feet} center of county road. At 483 feet change course. Thence S. $21^{\circ}30'E$ 1217 feet; Thence S. $36^{\circ}15'E$ 400 feet; Thence S. $57^{\circ}E$ at 400 feet crosses West line of Ysleta
