have Granted, Sold and Conveyed, and by these presents do Grant, Sell and Convey, unto the said Juan Armandariz

of the County of El Paso and State of Texas, all that certain piece, tract or parcel of land lying and being situated within the Corporate Limits of the Town of Socorro, El Paso County, Texas, formerly known as J. J. Thibault and more particularly described as follows, viz:

Beginning at a group of Tornillos on the bank of Old River, on the South side a road, opposite the N. E. corner of a tract of land in the name of Ynez Apodaca, a forked Alamo, bns. S. 15° E. and Arriandona Mill bns. S. 10° W., thence down the bank of Old River, S. 26° E 130 4/10 Varas, a stake from which a cottonwood tree worked X bns. N. 26° W. 2 Vrs., thence S. 33° E. along old River 199 varas to a stake, thence S. 45° E. 51 Varas to a cottonwood on the bank of Old River worked X from which a cottonwood worked ~~X~~ bns. N. 59° W. 8 1/10 Vrs., thence along the bank of Juan Armandariz S. 14° 15' E. 144 6/10 Vrs. to a stake, thence S. 71° 15' W. 86 Varas to a stake on the edge of a lagoon, thence S. 10° W. 19 7/10 Vrs. to a stake, thence S. 2 1/2° E. 84 5/10 Varas to a stake on the edge of the lagoon, thence S. 35° 30' W. 19 8/10 Varas to a stake, thence S. 65° 30' W. 111 2/10 Varas to a stake 10 Varas, from an old acquia, thence N. 50° 30' W. 160 Varas to a stake 20 Varas from said old acquia, thence N. 23° 45' W. 132 5/10 Vrs. to the corner of a tract of land owned by Juan Armandariz, from which a cottonwood bns. N. 81° E. thence N. 84° E. 162 7/10 Vrs. to a stake 6 Vrs. East of an arroyo from which a thorn pronged cottonwood worked F bns. N. 37° 30' E. 9 1/10 Vrs., thence N. 35° W. along the Arriandona tract 128 1/10 Vrs. a stake on the East side of the arroyo, thence N. 10° 30' W. 76 3/10 Vrs. to a stake on the bank of a ditch, thence N. 30° W. 122 5/10 Vrs. to a stake in a slough, thence N. 14° 30' W. 105 5/10 Vrs. to a stake on the south end of the tract of beginning, containing 22 8/10 acres of land.
