have Granted, Sold and Conveyed, and by these presents do Grant, Sell and Convey, unto the said P. Rico ^{of the County of El Paso and State of Texas}, all that certain piece, tract or parcel of land lying and being situated within the corporate limits of the town of Socorro, in said El Paso County, State of Texas, formerly known as J. J. Thibault Land, and more particularly described as follows, viz: Beginning at a stake on the North side of a road, at the North East corner of a tract of land owned by Otto Kortz, on the South line of a tract owned by George Laupman, from which the Center window of Arrendading Well, bears S. 18° W., thence N. 12° E., 381 Varas to a stake on the bank of Old River, thence N. 75° 30' E., 284 Varas to a stake, thence N. 44° E., 346 Varas to a stake, thence N. 56° 45' E., 461 Varas to a stake on the bank of the "Aquia de la otra banda de la Ysla" from which a Cottonwood, on the bank of Old River, marked — bro. S. 22° W., 15 Varas, so marked — bro. S. 33° 30' W., 7 Varas, thence North 77° E., 177 Varas to a stake on the bank of the aquia, thence N. 88° 45' E., crossing the aquia 219 Varas to the S. W. corner of a tract of land owned by Juan Arrendading, a stake 10 yrs from the bank of Old River, thence N. 9° 30' W., 125 yrs, to a post at the S.
