

CERTIFICATE.

I HEREBY CERTIFY, With reference to the following described land:

A tract of land in the north half of the northeast quarter sec. 29, T. 32 S., R. 7 E., containing 0.6 acre, more or less, El Paso County, Texas, more particularly described in quit-claim deed dated October 22, 1918, running from Norwood Hood to the United States of America:
