KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned owners of and water users on land situate in the County of El Paso and State of Texas, and within the boundaries of the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1, being desirous of obtaining more adequate drainage for our land do hereby petition for the Franklin Intercepting Drain. The construction to be accomplished by the United States Bureau of Reclamation, under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved June 17th, 1902 (32 Stat., 388), and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, and pursuant to a contract dated October 12th, 1922 between the Secretary of the Interior and the said El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1. For and in part consideration of the benefits to be derived from the construction of said intercepting drain, we hereby agree to convey to the United States or to the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1 all the necessary right-of-way required for its proper construction, operation and maintenance across our lands.

The location of the proposed drain and section is shown on the map attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof.

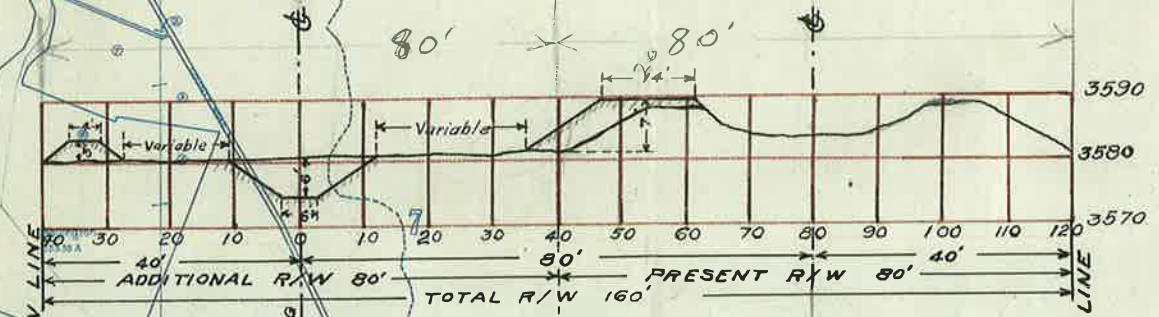
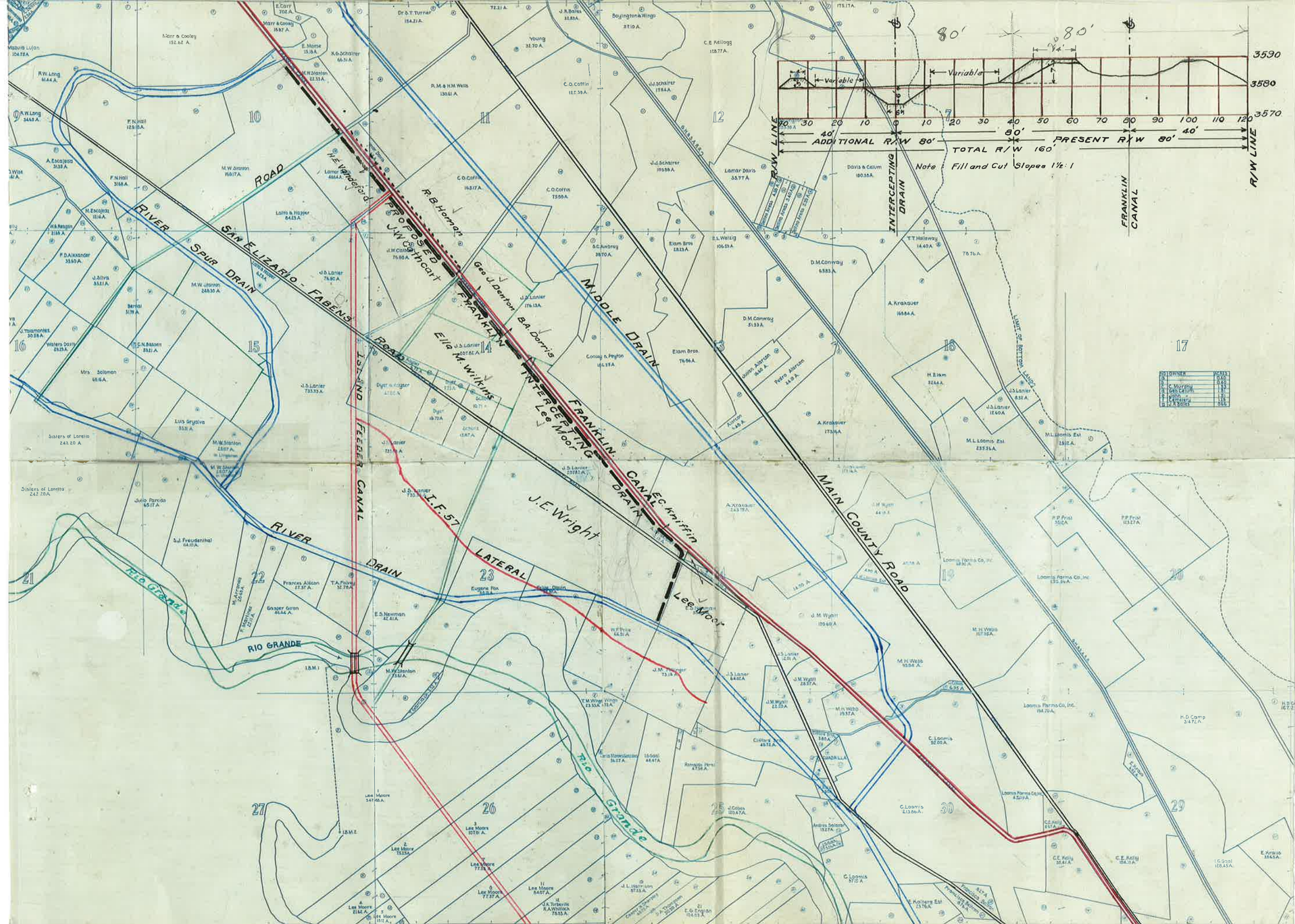
