The Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) has investigated your request to excess a portion of the Franklin Spur Drain of approximately 4.18 acres of Block 26, Tracts 11A1 and 11A, San Elizario Grant, El Paso County, Texas.

All courthouse records, tax statements, and the documentation maintained in Reclamation's office, indicate a 100-foot right-of-way was acquired by Petition Document. The right-of-way indicated above and shown in red on the enclosed plat has not been used and is not needed for Reclamation purposes.
