



- 2. Your attention is called to the certificate as to title accompanying this donation deed wherein it is stated that the land is not homestead property.
- 3. For further explanation please see our letter of May 3rd in regard to the Yldifonso Rodriguez donation deed, which was in answer to letter from Assistant to Director to Project Manager of April 29, 1919.
- 4. We have not overlooked the Manual regulation to the effect that it is advisable to have a wife, where one exists, to join in the conveyance. We might state the marital status of a male grantor, which would in most cases be merely to the effect that he was a married man, but the laws of Texas and New Mexico do not require that the wife join where the land is not homestead property. In numerous cases the parties themselves, or by their attorneys, object strongly to the wife's joining in the conveyance, and it is of little or no avail for us, and sometimes actually embarrassing, to cite Menual regulations in what appears to the local people to be an attempt to controvert the laws under which they are well accustomed to do business. In fact, a great many of our transactions are with business men of the city of El Paso and we are anxious to avoid wherever possible the accusation, frequently made, that we insist upon unnecessary formalities peculiar to this office.

  And your office will undoubtedly appreciate that our regulations are not paramount to State laws.
