KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned owners of water rights in the Jornada Community Ditch, for and in consideration of the benefits to accrue to us, respectively, by reason of the reconstruction, enlargement, and improvements of the said Jornada Community Ditch system to be hereafter performed by the United States of America, hereby disclaim and release all our right, title, and interest in and to the said Jornada Community Ditch system as the same is now constructed and in existence, as shown by the blueprint hereto attached and made a part hereof, and agree that the United States, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388), and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, may take charge of, operate, maintain, and control said ditch system and all appurtenances thereof, and shall have the right to reconstruct, enlarge, and otherwise improve the same in any manner deemed necessary by the proper officers of the United States in order that there may be afforded superior facilities for the irrigation of the lands tributary thereto.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENCE, That we, the undersigned, owners of land served with irrigation water by what is known as the Jornada Lateral, having on the 19th day of December, 1918, released all our rights, title and interest in and to the said Jornada Community Ditch as then constructed and in existence, in and for the consideration of the benefits to be derived by reason of the reconstruction, enlargement and improvement of and the operation of the said Jornada Community Ditch system, by the United States, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388) and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, now upon being presented with and informed of the plans of the United States for greatly improving the irrigation facilities to the lands served from the said Jornada Lateral by supplying an adequate and efficient irrigation head through and enlarged and improved ditch to be reconstructed as shown on the attached map and estimate, and upon which the necessary structures will be built, said map and estimate being hereto attached and hereby made a part hereof; do hereby signify our acquiescence in these plans and give them our hearty approval and agree to cooperate in the accomplishment of said improvement by permitting the reconstruction and enlargement to be carried out where the ditch passes through our lands, following as closely as practicable the line of the present ditch. We furthermore agree to lend our full and earnest cooperation in the future operation of this lateral.

Estimated Cost for the Reconstruction of the Jornada Lateral

It is proposed to reconstruct and enlarge the Jornada Lateral for a distance of 14,500 feet from its heading in the Franklin Canal, installing all necessary new structures. The new ditch is to have a capacity of not less than twenty cubic feet per second with a bottom width of four feet.
