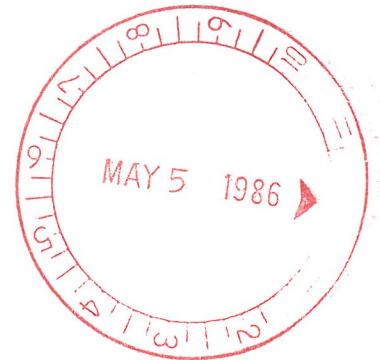

It has been brought to our attention by the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1, via letter dated April 23, 1986 (copy enclosed), that a safety problem exists at the Padilla Street Siphon if it is left exposed without protective fencing around the inlet and outlet concrete transitions. Reclamation is aware that the City of El Paso (the City) has taken steps to correct this problem. This was done via telephone conversation of April 19, 1986, between you and Mr. Joe Hernandez of my staff. It is most urgent that the City act on this request as there is considerable foot traffic taking place between Capistrano Elementary School and the Kennedy Brothers Public Housing Project. All fencing and or safety racks shall be constructed according to Reclamation's design criteria, figures three and four. If you have any questions, please contact Joe Hernandez at 541-7724.

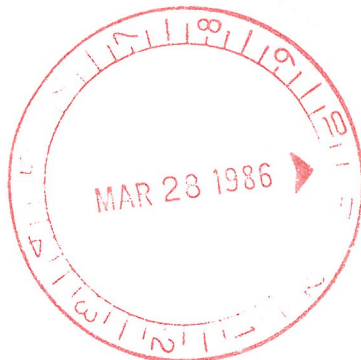

RIGHT OF WAY FOR PADILLA DRIVE IMPROVEMENTS  
AT THE JORNADO LATERAL CROSSING

Portion of Tract 3C, Block 40, Ysleta Grant

PARCEL 3

Legal description of a portion of land out of Tract 3C1, Block 40, Ysleta Grant, Belonging to U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, to be shared with the City of El Paso, Texas through a license agreement for right of way purposes and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a City monument at the centerline intersection of Schutz Drive (60 feet right of way) and Padilla Drive (45 feet right of way), thence South  $88^{\circ}02'00''$  West, along the center line of Padilla Drive, a distance of thirty three and twenty seven hundredths (33.27) feet to a point, thence South  $79^{\circ}13'00''$  West, along the center line of Padilla Drive, a distance of two hundred seventy two and seventy hundredths (272.70) feet to a point, thence South  $71^{\circ}54'00''$  West, along the center line of Padilla Drive, a distance of one hundred twenty one and ninety hundredths (121.90) feet to a point, thence South  $60^{\circ}52'00''$  West along the centerline of Padilla Drive, a distance of two hundred fifty nine and fifty nine hundredths (259.59) feet to the northwesterly corner of Tract 18-B, Block 42, Ysleta Grant, thence North  $10^{\circ}00'00''$  West, a distance of thirty one and seventy five hundredths (31.75) feet to the southwesterly corner of Tract 3-C1, Block 40, Ysleta Grant, to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING for this parcel of land,

Thence North  $80^{\circ}13'00''$  West, a distance of thirty seven and seventy hundredths (37.70) feet to a point,

Thence North  $10^{\circ}00'00''$  West, a distance of seven and four hundredths (7.04) feet to a point on a curve,

Thence along a curve to the left, an arc distance of thirty five and fifty eight hundredths (35.58) feet, said curve has a radius of two hundred eighty six and ninety seven hundredths (286.97) feet, a central angle of  $7^{\circ}00'14''$ , a tangent length of seventeen and eighty one hundredths (17.81) feet, and a chord distance of thirty five and fifty six hundredths (35.56) feet bearing North  $83^{\circ}53'48''$  East to a point,

Thence South  $10^{\circ}00'00''$  East, a distance of seventeen and thirty eight hundredths (17.38) feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING for this parcel of land.

Said parcel of land contains 420.15 square feet or .00965 acres more or less.
