Eerrera Community DITCHES in and unto those certain ditches or canals known as the San
Jose, Pena and Juan de Herrera Ditches lying in the County of El Paso, and State of Texas,
more particularly described in blue prints hereto attached and made a part hereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all the right, title, interest, estate and claim of the said San Jose, Pena and Juan de Merrera Community Ditches in and to the said premises, together with all and singular, the rights, privileges and appurtenances to the same in any manner belonging, unto the said United States of America, its successors and assigns forever; Provided: That nothing herein contained shall be construed as a conveyance, interference with or in any wise affecting the vested right of any holder of rights in the said San Jose, Pena and Juan de Herrera Ditches to the use of water from the Rio Grande.
