2. THE COLLEGE WILL

For and in consideration of the payments to be made by the United States as hereinafter provided, and of the covenants herein contained, the Vendor does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to the United States free and clear of any lien or encumbrance, all buildings, fences, ditches, seedings, growing crops, trees, and shrubbery, and any and all other improvements of whatsoever kind or nature, upon, attached to, or growing upon that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the county of Rl Paso, State of Texas, particularly described as follows to wit:

A tract of land approximately (4) four miles northwest of the town of Yelets, Texas, in the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter (NW18W1 of section nine(9) township thirty-one(31) south range six(6) east, United States Reclamation Service survey and being also in survey number one hundred sixty-one (161) of the Yeleta Grant and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of the tract of land herein described which is a point on the property line between land of the Vendor and Jose Luna, said commer being also a point on a sex hundred sixty-six and seventy-eight hundredths (666.78) feet redius curve the tangent of which curve at said point bears south seventy-two (72)degrees forty-one (41)minutes ten (10)seconds east and from which point the southwest corner of said section nine(9) bears south twentythree(23)degrees fifty-four(54)minutes ten(10)seconds west one thousand five hundred and fifteen-hundredths (1500.15) feet; thence slots said

property line north one(1) degree thirty-four(34)minutes east seventy and forty-seven hundred the (70.47) feet to the corner common to land of the Vendor and said Jose Lana; thence along the property line between land of the Vendorand M. L. Cadwallader south eightyseven(87)degrees fifty-six(56)minutes east eighty-six and two-tenths 66.2) feet to the northwest corner of land of the Vendor; thence along the east line of land of the Vendor south two(2)degrees four(04)minutes west one hundred and fifteen-hundredths (100.15) feet to a point on a six hundred sixty-six and seventy-eight hundredths (666.78)ft. radius curres the tangent of which curve at said last mentioned point bears north sixty-four (64) degrees fifty-four (54) minutes west and from which point the southwest corner of said section nine (9) bears south twenty-seven(27)degrees twenty(20)minutes thirty(30)seconds west one thousand five hundred seven and one-tenth(1507.1)feet; thence westerly and to the left along said last mentioned curve a distance of ninety and fifty-four hundredths (90.54) feet, based on a 100-feet chord, to the point of beginning; said tract of land containing sixteen hundredths (0.16) acre, more or less.

The Vendor, on behalf of themselves heirs and assigns, releases and acquite and discharges the United States and its assigns from any and all liability for damages or compensation arising from the entry upon said parcel of land and from the construction, operation, and maintenance thereon of works pertaining to the United States Reclamation Service.

4. In consideration whereof, the United States agrees to pay to the Vendor the sum of Thirty-two 00/100 (\$32.00)

Dollars, upon government voucher, by Treasury warranty, or disbursing officer's check, as full purchase price of said improvements and as full payment for all damages by reason of the matters and things stated herein.

- 5. The Vendor hereby ratifies and confirms the grant to the United States of the right of way across lands herein referred to in stock-subscription contract with the El Paso Valley Water Users' Association.
- 6. The Vender will furnish before payment, satisfactory evidence that they are the owners of said improvements & and the land on which the same are situated, and that the same are free from any lien or encumbrance, and for this purpose will submit any abstract or title papers which they may have in their possession for examination; but the United States will at its own expense and for its own use procure such abstract as may be becausery for the investigation of the title to said land and improvements, and may make and retain copies of the abstract and title papers submitted by the Vendor for examination.
- 7. The Vendor upon request by the proper offi cials of the Reclamation Service, will procure and have recorded, where proper for record, all deeds of other assurances of title, and affidavits and other evidences of title which in the opinion of Counsel for the Reclamation Service are necessary to show good title unencumbered in the Vendor to the property purchased.

- 8. Liens or encumbrances against the property purchased may, at the option of the United States, be discharged at the time of payment, or a sufficient amount for this purpose be retained from the purchase price and the same discharged with the money so retained, but this provision shall not be construed to give precedence of any lien of encumbrance over this agreement, nor as an assumption of the same by the United States.
- 9. The United States agrees to permit the Vendor to retain possession of the strip or parcel of land upon which said improvements are located and to use and enjoy the same, and remove crops therefrom that may mature thereon, until ten days after the date hereof, unless prior thereto it becomes necessary to p occupy said strip of land for ditch or canal purposes, in which event the Vendor will be duly notified by the proper Reclamation officials; and the Vendor agrees that whenever so notified he will immediately yield and deliver up the possession of I said strip of land together with the improvements thereon, without any claim for damage or compensation other than as herein provided.

The contractor expressly warrants that he has employed no third person to solicit or obtain this contract in his behalf, or to cause or procure the same to be obtained upon compensation in any way contingent, in whole or in part, upon such procurement; and that he has not paid, or promised or agreed to pay, to any third person, in consideration of such procurement, or in compensation for services in connection therewith, any brokerage, commission, or percentage upon the amount receivable by him hereunder; and that he has not, in estimating the contract price demanded by him, included any sum by reason of any such brokerage, commission, or percentage; and that all moneys payable to him hereunder are free from obligation to any other person for services rendered, or supposed to have been rendered, in the procurement of this contract. He further agrees that any breach of this warranty shall constitute adequate cause for the annulment of this contract by the United States, and that the United States may retain to its own use from any sums due or to become due thereunder an amount equal to any brokerage, commission, or percentage so paid or agreed to be paid: *Provided*, however, It is understood that this covenant does not apply to the selling of goods through a bona fide commercial representative employed by the contractor in the regular course of his business in dealing with customers other than the Government and whose compensation is paid, in whole or in part, by commissions on sales made, nor to the selling of goods through established commercial or selling agents or agencies regularly engaged in selling such goods.

the contract is made contingent upon Congress making the necessary appropriation for expenditures thereunder after such current year has expired. In case such appropriation as may be necessary to carry out this contract is not made, the contractor hereby releases the United States from all liability due to the fallure of Congress to make such appropriation.
