Jose Luna and Faustina D. de Luna, his wife,
hereinafter styled Contractor, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.

WITNESSETH: The parties covenant and agree that-

22. The Control of the payments to be made by the United States as hereinafter provided, and of the covenants herein contained, the Vendor does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to the United States free and clear of any lien or encumbrance, all buildings, fences, ditches, seedings, growing crops, trees, and shrubbery, and any and all other improvements of whatsoever kind or nature, upon, attached to, or growing upon that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the county of RI Paso, State of Texas, particularly described as follows, to wife

A tract of land approximately four(4) wiles northwest of the town of Yeleta, Texas, in the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter(m\(\frac{1}{2}\)\)\ mection nine(9), township thirty-one(31) south, range six(6) east. United States Reclamation Service survey, and being also in survey no. one hundred sixty-one(161) of the Yeleta Grant and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of the tract of land herein described, which is a point on the property line between land of the Vender and Enrique Luna, and from which point the southwest corner of the said section nine(9) bears south five(5) degrees seven(07) minutes thirty(50) seconds west one thousand four hundred eighteen and two hundred ths(1418.02) feet; thence along said property line north one (1) degrees thirty(50) minutes west forty-seven and one-tenth(47.1) feet to the corner common to land of the Vender and the said Enrique Luna;

thence along the property line between land of the Vendor and M. L. Cadwallader, south eighty-seven (87) degrees fifty-six (50) minutes east four hundred eighty-four and fifty-seven hundred the 484.57) feet to the corner common to land of the Wendor and Elizario Luna; thence along the property line between land of the Vendor and said Elizario Luna. south one (1) degree thirty-four (34) minutes west seventy and forty-seven hundredths (70.47) feet to a point on a six hundred sixty-six and seventy eight hundred the (666.78) feet radius curve the tangent of which curve at said last mentioned point bears north seventy-two (72) degrees fortyone (41) minutes ten (10) seconds west and from which point the southwest corner of said section nine (9) bears south twenty-three (23) degrees fiftyfour (54) minutes ten (10) seconds west one thousand five hundred and fifteenhundredths(1500.15)feet; thence westerly and to the left along said curve a distance of one hundred seventy-six and ninety-one hundred the (176.91) feet measured on one hundred (100) foot chords; thence north eighty-seven (87) degrees fifty-six (56) minutes west three hundred six and ninety-four hundred the 13064944 feet to the point of beginning; said tract of land containing fifty-five hundred the (0.55) agre-more less.

- 7. The Vendor, on behalf of heirs and assigns, releases and acquits and discharges the United States and its assigns from any and all liability for damages or compensation arising from the entry upon said parcel of land and from the construction, operation and maintenance thereon of works pertaining to the United States Reclamation Service.
- 4. In consideration whereaft, the United aliases cagrees to pay to the Vendor the sum of one hundred and ten and 0/100 (\$110.00)Dollars, upon government voucher, by Treasury warranty, or disbursing officer's check, as full purchase price of said improvements and as full payment for all damages by reason of the matters and things stated herein.
- 5. The Vendor hereby ratifies and confirms the grant to the United States of the right of way across lands herein referred to in stock-subscription contract with the El Paso Valley Water Users! Association.
- 6. The Vendor will furnish before payment, satisfactory evidence that the is the owner of said improvements and the land on which the same are situated, and that the same are free from any lien or encumbrance, and for this purpose will submit any abstract of title papers which the hap have in possession for examination; but the United States will at its own expense and for its own use procure such abstract as may be necessary for the investigation of the title to said land and improvements, and may make and retain copies of the abstract and title papers submitted by the Vendor for examination.
- 7. The Vendor upon request by the proper officials of the Reclamation Service, will procure and have recorded, where proper for record, all deeds or other assurances of title, and affidavits and other evidences of title which in the opinion of Counsel for the Reclamation Service are necessary to show good title unencumbered in the Vendor to the property purchased.

- 6. Liens of encumbrances against the property purchased may, at the option of the United States, be discharged at the time of payment, or a sufficient amount for this purpose be retained from the purchase price and the same discharged with the money so retained, but this provision shall not be construed to give precedence of any lien or encumbrance over this agreement, nor as an assumption of the same by the United States.
- 9. The United States agrees to permit the Vendor to retain possession of the strip or parcel of land upon which said improvements are located and to use and enjoy the same, and remove crops therefrom that may mature thereon, until ten days after the date hereof, unless prior thereto it becomes necessary to occupy said strip of land for ditch purposes, in which event the Vendor will be duly notified by the proper Resignation officials; and the Vendor agrees that whenever so notified he will immediately yield and deliver up the possession of said strip of land together with the improvements thereon, without any claim for damage or compensation other than as herein provided.

10. The contractor expressly warrants that he has employed at third person to solicit or obtain this contract in his behalf, or to cause or procure the same to be obtained upon compensation in any way contingent, in whole or in part, upon such procurement; and that he has not paid, or promised or agreed to pay, to any third person, in consideration of such procurement, or in compensation for services in connection therewith, any brokerage, commission, or percentage upon the amount receivable by him hereunder; and that he has not, in estimating the contract price demanded by him, included any sum by reason of any such brokerage, commission, or percentage; and that all moneys payable to him hereunder are free from obligation to any other person for services rendered, or supposed to have been rendered, in the procurement of this contract. He further agrees that any breach of this warranty shall constitute adequate cause for the annulment of this contract by the United States, and that the United States may retain to its own use from any sums due or to become due thereunder an amount equal to any brokerage, commission, or percentage so paid or agreed to be paid: Provided, however, It is understood that this covenant does not apply to the selling of goods through a bona fide commercial representative employed by the contractor in the regular course of his business in dealing with customers other than the Government and whose compensation is paid, in whole or in part, by commissions on sales made, nor to the selling of goods through established commercial or selling agents or agencies regularly engaged in selling such goods.

Where the operations of this contract extend beyond the current fiscal year it is understood that the contract is made contingent upon Congress making the necessary appropriation for expenditures thereunder after such current year has expired. In case such appropriation as may be necessary to carry out this contract is not made, the contractor hereby releases the United States from all hability
