Goebel, assignee of Zacharia Taliaferro White, Charles Brook Stevens and the heirs or devisees of Horace Bickford Stevens, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 975), entitled "An Act providing for the issuance of patents upon certain conditions to lands and accretions thereto determined to be within the State of New Mexico, in accordance with the decree of the Supreme Court of the United States entered April 9, 1928," for the Tract forty-four embracing a portion of Sections five and six in Township twenty-nine south of Range four east of the New Mexico Meridian, New Mexico, containing nineteen acres and eight hundred two thousandths of an acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, approved February 10, 1933, accepted June 13, 1933 and officially filed in the General Land Office October, 1, 1934:
