QUITCLAIM DEED

This Indenture, made the 7th day of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and 41, between John W. Moore, and Mrs. Laura Moore, his wife

part. 1/5 of the first part, and the United States of America, party of the second part, in pursuance of the provisions of the act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 368), and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto.

Witnesseth: That the part. 1/5 of the first part, for and in consideration of the allowance of credits in the sum of One hundred forty and 40/100 Dollars (\$140.00) upon the construction charge assessments of the Elephant Butte Irrigation District against lands of the said part. 1/5 of the first part, and contract of August 30, 1939 pursuant to contract of Dec. 20, 1929, between the said District and the United States, do by these premises demise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns, all that certain lot, piece, or parcel of land situated in the County of Dona Ana, and State of New Mexico, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to wit:

A tract of land lying and situate in Dona Ana County, New Mexico, and in the South east quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) and Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of Section eighteen (18) Township twenty-six (26) South, Range three (3) East, N.M.P.M., Bureau of Reclamation Survey and within Private Claim No. 49 Tract 1, shown on Dona Ana County, New Mexico, Plat Book as tract numbered 1667; more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north property line of the land of the grantors and from which point the Northwest corner of Section eighteen (18) Township twenty-six (26) South, Range three (3) East, N.M.P.M., Bureau of Reclamation Survey bears North seventy degrees (70°) eighteen minutes (18') forty-five seconds (45") West four thousand six hundred eighty-nine and six tenths (4689.6) feet; thence North seventy-five degrees (75°) fifty minutes (50') East one hundred twenty-six and four tenths (126.4) feet along the north property line of the land of the grantors to a point on a curve of one thousand two hundred fifteen and ninety-two hundredths (1215.92) feet radius; the tangent to the curve at said point having a bearing of North twenty-two degrees (22°) twenty-nine minutes (29') sixteen seconds (16") West; thence to the right along said curve of one thousand two hundred fifteen and ninety-two hundredths (1215.92) feet radius two hundred fifty-nine and seven tenths (259.7) feet; thence South ten degrees (10°) fifteen minutes (15') East one thousand one hundred twenty-one and nine tenths (1121.9) feet to a point on the property line of the land of the grantors and from which point the Northeast corner of Section eighteen (18) Township twenty-six (26) South, Range three (3) East N.M.P.M., Bureau of Reclamation Survey bears North seven degrees (7°) fifty-three minutes (53') East two thousand nine hundred twenty-seven and five tenths (2927.5) feet; thence South fifty-five degrees (55°) twenty-nine minutes (29') West along said last mentioned property line one hundred thirty-seven and one tenth (137.1) feet; thence North ten degrees (10°) fifteen minutes (15') West one thousand one hundred seventy-eight and three tenths (1178.3) feet; thence to the left along a curve of one thousand ninety and ninety-two hundredths (1090.92) feet radius two hundred forty-two and eight tenths (242.8) feet; thence North twenty-three degrees (23°) West nine and three tenths (9.3) feet to the point of beginning. 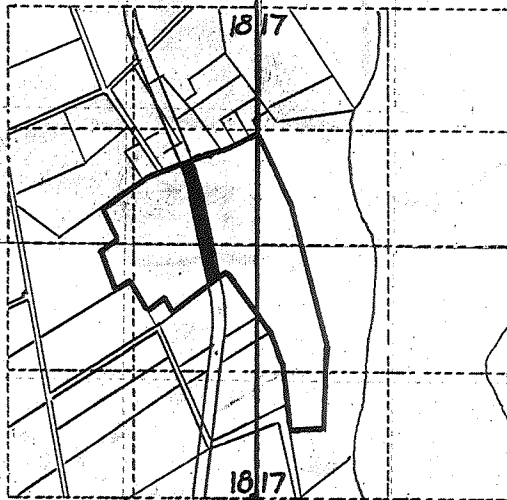

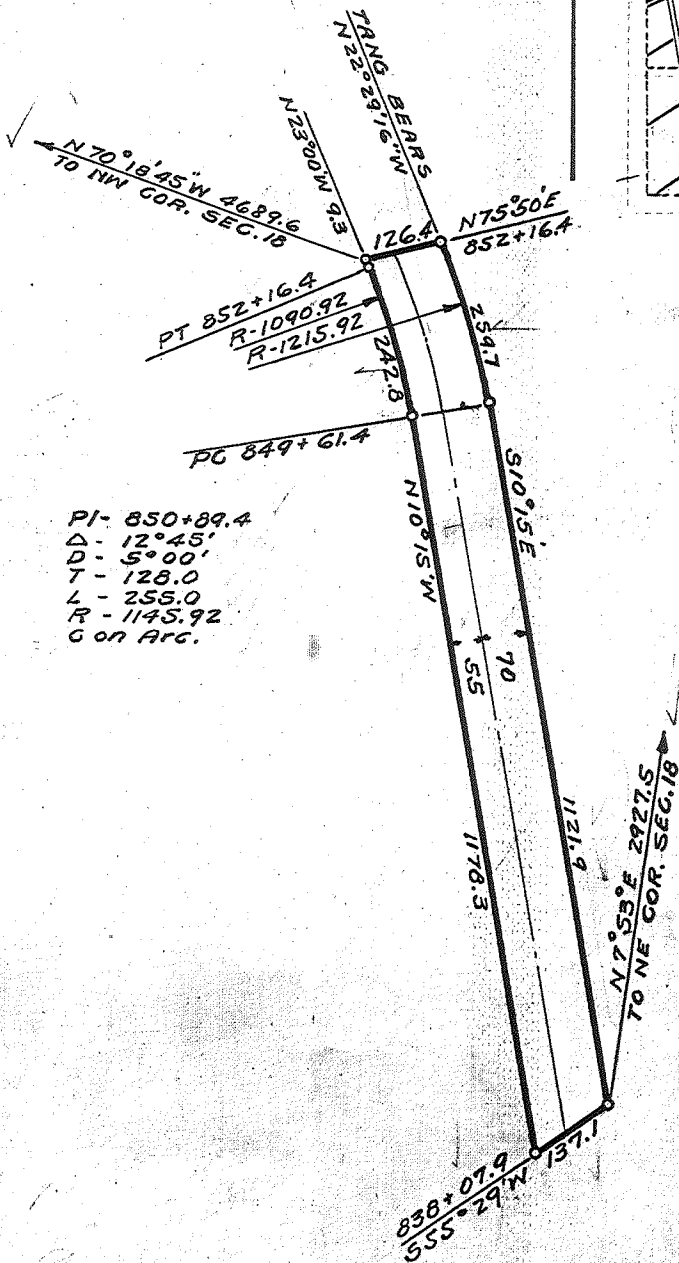


