A tract of land situated approximately three-quarters of a mile west of the town of Canutillo, Texas, in the north half of the northwest quarter of section two (2), Township twenty-eight (28) south, range three (3) east, and the west half of the southwest quarter of section thirty-five (35), township twenty-seven (27) south, range three (3) east, United States Reclamation Service survey, more particularly bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner, a point on the property line between the Grantor herein and E. E. McIntyre, from which point the northwest corner of said section two (2) bears north 73°49' west one thousand two hundred and ninety-nine (1,299) feet; running thence north 01°30' west three hundred sixty-one and six-tenths (361.6) feet; thence north 10°12' west five hundred sixty-two and seven-tenths (562.7) feet; thence north 18°54' west one thousand nine hundred forty and five-tenths (1,940.5) feet; thence south 89°56' east one hundred twenty-six and nine-tenths (126.9) feet on the line between the property of the Grantor herein and the Canutillo road; thence south 18°54' east two thousand two hundred two and two-tenths (2,202.2) feet; thence south 01°30' east six hundred sixty-seven and seven-tenths (667.7) feet; thence west one hundred and twenty (120) feet on the property line between the Grantor herein and E. 
