For and in consideration of the payments to be made by the United States, as hereinafter provided, and of the covenants herein contained, and Vendor does hereby sell, assign, transfer, and set over to the United States free and clear of any lien or incumbrance, all buildings, fences, ditches, seedings, growing crops, trees, and shrubbery, and any and all other improvements of whatsoever kind or nature, upon, attached to, or growing upon that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the County of El Paso, State of Texas, particularly described as follows:

Lying in the town of Cuadrilla, Texas, in the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter (SE-NE) section twenty-five (25), township thirty-three (33) south, range seven (7) east, and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter (SW-NW-) section thirty (30), town-ship thirty-three (33) south, range eight (8) east, United States Reclamation Service survey, and being also in the San Elizario Grant Tract No. 1, and beginning at a point on the easterly right of way line of the Cuadrilla lateral, the property of the United States, for the northeast corner of the tract of land herein described, and from which point the northeast corner of the said section twenty-five (25) bears north twelve (12) degrees five (5) minutes east one thousand nine hundred thirty-nine and sixty-two hundredths (1939.62) feet nine hundred thirty-nine and sixty-two hundredths (1939.62) feet distant; thence south thin forty-three (43) degrees thirty-one (31) minutes east ninety and fifteen-hundredths (90.15) feet; thence

- As a further consideration there will be constructed by and at the expense of the United States a farm bridge of the standard design adopted and now being used on the Rio Grande project; said bridge shall be constructed at or near station 108 \$ 25 of the River Drain and work thereupon shall be commenced


and completed within a reasonable time after excavation of said drain at the paint mentioned. Upon completion of the said bridge the same shall become the property of the Vendor, but the United States shall have the right to use the same in the operation and maintenance of said drain. The vendor shall keep the said bridge in such condition as to be suitable for such use by the United States and so as not to interfere with the proper operation and maintenance of said drain.


