

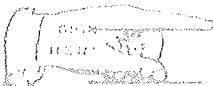

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, owners of land situated in the County of El Paso and State of Texas, and within the boundaries of the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1, being desirous of securing the irrigation, drainage and reclamation of our land in accordance with plans formulated, and to be hereafter formulated, by the United States of America under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved June 17, 1902 (32 Stat., 388) and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto, and pursuant to contract of January 17, 1920, and contract of October 12, 1922, supplementary thereto, between the Secretary of the Interior and the said El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1, for and in consideration of the benefits to be derived from the construction and operation of said irrigation, drainage and protective works, upon or in the vicinity of our lands and for other valuable considerations hereby agree to convey to the United States or the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1 all necessary right of way for the proper construction, operation and maintenance of them across any and all tracts of land belonging to the undersigned, or any of them, for what is known to be known as the River Drain and the Rio Lateral and Levee, as the same is now located and staked out on the ground or as same may be hereafter duly located and staked out by the proper representatives of the United States Reclamation Service. Said right of way shall be conveyed by proper quitclaim deed or deeds, or other appropriate instrument in writing, at any time such conveyance may be demanded by the proper agents and representatives of the United States or said Improvement District after the construction and operation of said works shall have been definitely determined upon by the United States, or actually constructed and in operation.

The approximate proposed location of said River Drain and Rio Lateral and Levee is shown on the map which is attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof. The location, however, is subject to minor adjustments as plans mature and the final constructed location may vary somewhat from the preliminary proposed line as shown. Insofar as it is feasible and practical the location of the Drain is to follow the lowest ground, and it is understood that the land on the river side will receive its irrigation from the Rio Lateral to be located along the Levee on the higher ground next to the river, and that the land across the Drain from the river will receive its irrigation from the San Elizario Lateral, thus avoiding construction of unnecessary flumes.
