Survey, Ysleta Grant, and lying North and South of the toes of slope of the present San Elizario Canal and containing .62 of an acre; being the land owned by Vendor included in a strip of land 150 feet wide lying 75 feet on each side of a center line described as follows: Beginning at Sta. 41+23.1 of said center line a point on the property line of land between Vendor and F. G. Alderete, said property line bearing South 89°25' East and from which point the Northeast corner of Section 11, Township 32 South, Range 6 East, lies North 43°36.1 feet and East 31.6 feet; thence South 49°39'30" East 404.4 feet; thence South 43°24' East 250.4 feet; to Sta. 47+77.9 of said center line a point on the property line between Vendor and I. In connection with the Rio Grande Reclamation project,
