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This deed was executed under date of June 11, 1921, but was not filed for record until Sept. 30, 1921, having been withheld from record for some time in order to examine probate records with a view to ascertaining condition of title in the grantor. Deed was returned from record Oct. 17, 1921, and the instrument, with related papers, was at once prepared for forwarding to Washington office for acceptance. Mr. Lawson returned papers with notation, "Hold for later develop-ment." Mr. Lawson stated that Mrs. Rawley had received some consideration from near-by (InadServesions) wished the canal constructed and that it was in view of such consideracanal constructed and that it was in view of such consideration that she wished was willing to donate the necessary
right of way to the United States. The canal has never been
constructed. Later Mrs. Rawley returned the consideration
she had received to the parties giving same. Mrs. Rawley
now (at time of Mr. Lawson's statement) wishes to retract
her donation to the United States. No information to this
effect ever reached District Counsel's office prior to time
of recordation of deed, and if such information had then
been at hand it would have been an easy matter to withhold been at hand it would have been an easy matter to withhold deed from record and cancel same if Project did not desire to use right of way. No information is at present at hand as to whether Mrs. Rawley's action precluded construction of the canal by the Service, or whether delay in such construction by the Service moved Mrs. Rawley to retract. Also, D. C. office cannot learn definitely whether right of way is still desired by Project, but there seems to be a possibility of future construction of the canal. Unless the Service was a party to the Rawley-Servatious transaction whereby the consideration was returned to the latter by Mrs. Rawley, we could demand that this grantor stand by the legal effect of her deed. Mr. Hoadley stated he knew nothing of these developments. The land donated by A. B. C. Serkin by deed dated June 15, 1921, appears to be in the same status, except that Gerkin (apparently) did not receive any consideration from other land owners. We understand that Mrs. Rawley would object if construction across her land were now attempted, but that Gerkin would not. To date Mrs. Rawley has made no move to have her deed cancelled, but Mrg. Hoadley intimates that she probably will do so when she learns that same has been recorded and now operates as a subsisting grant of some her land.


