This Indenture, made the 20th day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and forty, between Wm. W. Martin, Era Martin, his wife, and M. L. Thomas, a single man parties of the first part, and the United States of America, party of the second part, in pursuance of the provisions of the act of June 17, 1902

(32 Stat. 368), and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto.

WITNESSETH: That the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the allowance of credits in the sum of one hundred thirty-three and no/100 dollars (\$133.00) upon the construction charge assessments of the Elephant Butte Irrigation District against lands of the said parties of the first part, pursuant to contract of Dec. 20, 1929 and contract of August 30, 1939, between the said District and the United States, do by these premises demise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns, all that certain lot, piece, or parcel of land situated in the County of Dona Ana, and State of New Mexico, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to wit:

A tract of land lying and situate in Dona Ana County, New Mexico, in the North half (Ng) of the Southwest quarter (SN1) of Section one (1), Township twenty-six (26) South, Range two (2) East N.M.P.M., Bureau of Reclamation Survey and within tract numbered 1534 as shown on Dona Ana County, New Mexico, Plat Book; more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south property line of the land of the grantors and from which point the Southeast corner of Section one (1) Township twenty-six (26) South, Range two (2) East N.M.P.M., Bureau of Reclamation Survey bears South sixtyseven degrees (670) forty-three minutes (431) thirteen seconds (13") East three thousand six hundred ten and seven tenths (3610.7) feet; thence North eighty-nine degrees (89°) forty-four minutes (44') West one hundred twenty-six and three tenths (126.3) feet; thence North twenty-nine degrees (29°) eleven minutes (11') West one thousand two hundred fifty-five and seven tenths (1255.7) feet; thence North twentyseven degrees (270) thirty-eight minutes (38') West two hundred fifty-three and five tenths (253.5) feet to a point on the north property line of the land of the grantors; from which the Southwest corner of Section one (1) Township twenty-six (26) South, Range two (2) East, N.M.P.M., Bureau of Reclamation Survey bears South twenty-three degrees (23°) twenty-one minutes (21') ten seconds (10") West two thousand eight hundred ninety-one and five tenths (2891.5) feet; thence North eighty-nine degrees (89°) fifty-nine minutes (59') East along the north property line of the land of the grantors one hundred twenty-four and one tenth (124.1) feet; thence South twenty-, seven degrees (270) thirty-eight minutes (38') East one hundred ninety-four and five tenths (194.5) feet; thence South twenty-nine degrees (290) eleven minutes (11') East one thousand three hundred sixteen and three tenths (1316.3) feet to the point of beginning. 
